Call for Papers

Age-It is launching a Call for Papers for the General Meeting to be held in Venice, Ca'Foscari University, Campus Economico "San Giobbe".

During the meeting there will be parallel sessions dedicated to research carried out by **researchers of the Age-It Community**: each session will address a broad range of topics where different disciplinary approaches should be adopted. Each session will have to emphasize practice and policy implications and/or technological innovation in all age-related domains.

Papers can deal with any subject of the Age-It program. A scientific Committee will select the papers for the different sessions, for papers which are not yet at their final stage a poster session will also be organized.

How to submit

- The call **opens** 31 December 2023 and **closes** 7 February 2024, a dedicated platform is available <u>here</u>.
- The organizers wish to enable as many colleagues as possible to present their work; for that reason, only 1 submission as presenting author is allowed (you may co-author other papers or posters) and only 1 appearance as presenting author of a paper or a poster is allowed.
- Each submission must include a short Abstract (250 words) and an extended Abstract (2-4 pages describing topic, theoretical focus, data, methods and -expected-findings). A full paper is optional.
- Authors will be informed about **acceptance** of their submission by 15 March 2024.
